1. Mia has 7 apples. Her friend Noah gives her 5 more apples. How many apples does Mia have now?

2. Ethan sees 9 birds in a tree. Then 6 more birds land in the tree. How many birds are in the tree altogether?

3. Ava has 8 crayons in her box. She gets 4 more crayons from her teacher. How many crayons does she have now?

4. Lucas reads 6 pages of a book in the morning and 7 pages in the afternoon. How many pages does he read in all?

5. Sofia has 10 stickers. Her cousin gives her 9 more stickers. How many stickers does Sofia have altogether?

6. There are 11 ducks in a pond. Then 7 more ducks swim into the pond. How many ducks are there now?

7. Ben puts 5 toy cars on the shelf. Later, he adds 8 more toy cars. How many toy cars are on the shelf in total?

8. Emma picks 12 flowers. Later, she picks 6 more flowers. How many flowers does Emma have altogether?

9. A basket has 9 oranges. Another basket has 8 oranges. How many oranges are there in both baskets together?

10. Leo has 14 marbles. He finds 5 more marbles on the playground. How many marbles does Leo have now?
