4. Zach is collecting canned food for a food drive and he is starting with 10 cans from his own pantry. His aunt gives him 5 cans and his cousin gives him 4 more. How many cans does he have so far?

5. Josh has 24 grapes with his lunch and Tim has 12 grapes. How many more grapes does Josh have than Tim?
